FEATURES OF ASSET MAPPING

• Grass Roots Effort:

Uncovers resources/services/talents/skills found in the community right now – may expose existing gaps

• Internally Focused:

Relies on the community's own assets, not on those found outside

• Relationship Driven:


Seeks to build linkages among local people, institutions, and organizations

CORE THEORIES

- Assets: Gifts, talents, dreams, hopes, fears
- Relationships: Relationship-driven, constantly build connections
- Inside-out: Is self-sufficient and sustainable; Debunks the concept that outside resources are needed

BASIC STEPS

- Recognize & delineate assets
- Map/record the assets
- Mobilize assets and relationships towards the desired goal


