

■ GUARDIANSHIP/SUPPORTED DECISION-MAKING

At age 18 your child is emancipated, no matter their level of disability. Guardianship is the outcome of a legal process which designates a parent, another individual, or organization to act on behalf of an individual who may be unable to manage his/her affairs without assistance, beginning at age 18. Supported Decision making (SDM) is an inclusive alternative to guardianship. There are different types of guardianship and supported decision-making that vary based on the level of authority for the responsible party.
