WINTER CARE: All trees and shrubs shall be sprayed with an anti-desiccant the first November after WATERING: All plants shall be watered by the contractor during the initial growth stage. Trees shall be heavily watered several times during the first month after planting and then regularly for the next two

GENERAL: All plants, trees, and shrubs shall meet the specifications for 'plant material' as per the American Standard for Nursery Stock. The landscape architect reserves the the right to imprect all plants morn to shipping and installation. There are to be no substitutions of the plants without the concent of the landscape architect.

PLANTING: All plants shall be planted in pits two times the diameter of the root ball or container. Plant bright should be placed at or slightly above previous grades. Pull back burlay from top of ball and cut were not rece basket. Exerce that the burlay is not explosed below grade becase of water bass. Stalling and gaying shall be used only when necessary. When the method is used, care should be taken to protect the tree bark and views should be removed as soon as possible.

MULCHING: All planting beds (EXCEPT GROUNDCOVER) shall be mulched with three inches of shredded bark to conserve water and keep roots covered during initial growth stage. Do not place mulch heavily around crown of planting.

PLANT GUARANTEE: Contractor shall guarantee all newly installed plants for one-year provided that they are given proper watering/care and contractor is notified of unhealthy stressed plants immediately.
