How We Can Help

Sometimes a child needs more than just outpatient therapy and psychiatry. Sometimes a family and child need more support than the school alone can provide. C-SPOA can assist by providing a streamlined entry point for many supportive services in the county for youth that have a mental health diagnosis or are at risk for one. C-SPOA can help you navigate the eligibility process and all the options, and help you make the right decision for you and your family. We want to help create a team to wraparound your family. A team that will be with you through it all. A team that can connect you to services and support you in a non-judgmental manner.

Who is Eligible?

Any youth from 0-21 years of age that have a documented mental health diagnosis or may be showing signs that they are at risk for a diagnosis.

A Sneak-Peek at Services

Care Management and/or Health Home CM

- Someone to link you to and coordinate all services
- Help you and your child to create a strengths-based service plan with goals and objectives
- Support you during a crisis

Family Peer Support

- Someone with lived experience raising a youth with an emotional or behavioral challenge
- There to work with YOU, the caregiver, to support you and assist you in navigating different processes
- Someone to talk to and bounce new ideas and techniques off of

High Fidelity Wraparound (HFW)

- An evidenced based, nationally recognized care management model that empowers youth and families.
- Each family will have their own triad (Care manager, family worker and youth worker)

Child/Family Treatment Support Services (CFTSS)

An expansion to the state Continuum of Care which allows at-risk youth and those with a diagnosisg to access in-home and community supports such as:

- In-home therapy (OLP)
- Youth Peer Support (YPS)
- Skill Building (PSR)
- Hands on Counseling (CPST)

Although only for Medicaid-eligible youth, there are other pathways to access these services, so call us!

If your child is at imminent risk for an out-of-home placement, we also provide assistance and information regarding Community Residences (CR) and Residential Treatment Facilities (RTF).
