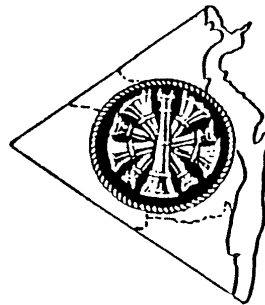

Emergency Button: Is on every new radio (Orange), when pressed a digital signal is sent to Motorola radio console system. simultaneously the radio's microphone is automatically keyed "open" and left for 10 seconds. The console system indicates which talkgroup is receiving the emergency signal.

"MAYDAY, MAYDAY, MAYDAY"

(Only if Firefighter seriously injured or needs to be rescued)

"ALL CLEAR"

(Transmitted to Incident Commander by Sector Commander to ensure all sectors are cleared.)

SPILL RESPONSE PROTOCOL

- The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) (1-800-457-7362 or via 44-Control) should be notified for all petroleum and chemical spills, despite the amount spilled, and obtain a spill number.
- Once a spill number has been obtained from the DEC, the caller should receive a callback from the DEC's on-call spill engineer within 20 minutes who will provide guidance on the necessary action required.
- The Rockland County Health Department **must** be notified of the spill through 44-Control. They will make a decision if a response is required.

NOTE: The properly trained fire department personnel should only eliminate source and contain the spill. They are not responsible to clean up or transport the spilled material to an approved disposal site.

PETROLEUM SPILL GUIDANCE AT A GLANCE

Petroleum spills must be reported to DEC within two hours of discovery, with one minor exception involving small spills. To fit within the exception, a small spill must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- The spill is known to be less than five gallons;
- The spill is contained and under the control of the spiller;
- The spill has not and will not reach the State's water or any land; and
- The spill is cleaned up within two hours of discovery.

If a spill does not satisfy all of these criteria, it must be reported to the DEC Hotline

RESPONDING TO SPILLS

- **Obtain wind direction and speed** from 44-Control.
- **Secure the scene** -- prevent unauthorized entry.
- **Set up Hot Zone** -- only properly trained personnel shall enter this area.
- **Establish a command post** -- upwind and in a safe location.
- **Identify the hazard** -- placards, container labels, shipping documents, MSDS, etc.
- **Assess the situation** -- consider the following:
 - Is there a fire, a spill or a leak?
 - What are the weather conditions?
 - What is the terrain like?
 - Who/what is at risk: people, property or the environment?
 - What actions should be taken: Is an evacuation necessary? Is diking necessary? What resources (human and equipment) are required and are readily available?
 - What can be done immediately?
 - Firefighters need to be certified in Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations level to legally perform any defensive tactic or function.

- For offensive functions, the firefighters need to be certified at the Hazardous Materials First Responder Technician level.

Information needed prior to contacting Chemtrec – call 1-800-424-9300 or via 44-Control.

- Your name, call back telephone number, 44-Control fax number
 - Location and nature of problem (spill, fire, etc.)
 - Name and identification number of material(s) involved
 - Shipper/consignee/point of origin
 - Carrier name, rail car or truck number
 - Container type and size
 - Quantity of material transported/released
 - Local conditions (weather, terrain, proximity to schools, hospitals, waterways, etc.)
 - Injuries and exposures
 - Local emergency services that have been notified
- The New York State Department of Environmental Control (DEC) should be notified for all petroleum and chemical spills, despite the amount spilled, and obtain a spill number (spill hotline number is 800-457-7362 or via 44-Control).
 - Once a spill number has been obtained from the DEC, the caller should receive a callback from the DEC's on-call spill engineer within 20 minutes who will provide guidance on the necessary action required. If a return call is not received within 20 minutes, then another call should be made to the DEC.
 - Request that 44-Control contact the Rockland County Health Department and notify the on-call Health Department engineer of the spill. He/she will make a decision if a response is required or corrective action can be handled over the telephone.

NOTE: The properly trained fire department personnel should only mitigate the spill. They are not responsible to clean up or transport the spilled material to an approved disposal site.

EMERGENCY SERVICES GUIDELINES FOR D.O.T. ASSISTANCE

The following guidelines should be utilized when emergency response organizations require the assistance of the Rockland County Division of the New York State Department of Transportation to the scene of an emergency on State highways.

- The employees of the Rockland based New York State Department of Transportation are not trained in hazardous materials response and cannot engage in spill cleanup.
- An incident that requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) assistance could include a spill, tree down, road obstruction, etc.
- When assistance is required, the following should take place:
 - Call Radio Headquarters (44-Control) and request a DOT supervisor to contact the on-scene Incident Commander. The Incident Commander must provide 44-Control with a call back number.

- Explain to the DOT supervisor the nature of the request, i.e., a truck rollover with a fuel spill on Rte. 9W and requesting traffic barricades for a road closure.
- The supervisor will either respond to the scene or dispatch the equipment requested by the Incident Commander.
- The supervisor will provide an estimated time of arrival.
- There could be a substantial delay during adverse weather conditions because crews are limited and assigned to other emergency tasks. There could also be a delay off hours and on holidays.
- One of the big requests is for sand to absorb a fuel spill. The DOT recommends that speedy dry be used to absorb a spilled material. Sand should only be used to dyke a spilled material or applied to the road surface for traction of a vehicle.

NOTE: The DOT will not remove sand, speedy dry, etc. when used at a fuel, motor oil, hydraulic oil or hazardous material spill.

USE OF BIOSOLVE

- Should the fire department decide to clean up a small hydrocarbon spill, BioSolve can be used provided the following is complied with:
 - BioSolve is to be used on surface (roadway, cement, blacktop) only. It should not be used on spilled material in a waterway, storm drain or on soil. With one exception, it can be used in storm drains and sewers if the primary purpose is to prevent an explosion. For example, a gasoline spill enters a storm drain and there is a concern of a fire/explosion, then BioSolve can be used.
 - BioSolve can be used on a spill and disposed of in the ordinary trash when the following is complied with:
 - When the spill is a hydrocarbon only.
 - BioSolve/water solution must be applied to the spilled material first and agitated.
 - Speedy dry must then be placed over the spilled area that was treated with BioSolve.
 - The maximum amount of speedy dry and BioSolve that can be disposed of is 220 lbs. This is about ½ of a 55-gallon drum.
 - BioSolve use on waterways or in storm drains:

Small Spill

- BioSolve “shall not be” used on a petroleum spill in a waterway, unless authorized by the New York State Department of Environmental Control (DEC) or the United States Coast Guard.

Large Spill

- If a spill exceeds a total of 220 lbs. of BioSolve, speedy dry and spilled material during a clean up, then a spill contractor must be notified by the spiller or the DEC.

MERCURY SPILL

All spills of mercury from a home fever thermometer or home thermostat can be cleaned up by the homeowner. They can obtain information on how to clean up a small mercury spill from the New York State Health Department (www.nyhealth.gov/nysdoh/environ/hsees/mercury) or by calling 800-458-1158, Ext. 2-7810. The fire department should not have any involvement. The typical fever thermometer contains about a half gram of mercury.

If the amount of mercury spilled is larger than what is expected from a fever thermometer or home thermostat, then the County Health Department or Hazmat officer needs to be contacted and the area evacuated until it is cleaned.

- Compact Fluorescent Bulb's contain small amounts of Mercury: about 1/100 the amount in a common household thermometer.
- What to do if one breaks?
 - Do Not inhale vapor
 - Do Not use a vacuum for cleanup
 - Sweep the pieces together with brush or broom – NOT with your hand.
 - Clean glass with wet rag or towel and place the towel along with glass into sealed plastic bag, and take to Household Hazardous Waste. (Open Mon-Fri 8 AM – 1 PM).

NOTE: The fire department should not be cleaning up a mercury spill.

DECONTAMINATION

In the event that a resident or emergency worker comes in contact with a hazardous substance and requires immediate gross decontamination (decon), the fire department should call but not wait for the arrival of County Hazmat. They should perform the following:

- Should the victims require immediate decon, then proceed without setting up a containment pool. Keep in mind that protection of life comes first and there should not be any delay in providing decon.
- If time permits, set up a decon pool to capture the water or liquid runoff.
- Decon support units can be dispatched to the scene from the County Hazmat Team and the following local fire Departments: Nyack, and West Haverstraw. The Hazmat Team should be notified for all requests for decon support.
- Stationary decon units are located at Nyack and Good Samaritan Hospitals. Have 44-Control notify the emergency room of the receiving hospital that a contaminated victim is in-route and what level of decon was provided at the scene.

FIRE SAFETY PROGRAMS

We can provide fire safety programs for students, grades Pre-K to 6. These age and grade appropriate programs feature in-classroom instruction by NYS certified instructors, supporting materials, an emphasis on fire safety and prevention, availability of field trip to Fire Safety Building, and award of Fire Safety Certificate of Merit to each student.

“Fire Safety Building” - This is a full size house which is used for firefighter training (search & rescue and other operations) and public fire safety education. This house features: fire detection systems, residential sprinklers, a smoke machine, various types of doors and windows to practice escape procedures, and a classroom for presentation of films/videos. The structure is built like a ranch house, consisting of: three bedrooms, one bathroom, a kitchen and a living room. Groups are taken through a realistic, simulated fire/smoke situation. Students are taught escape procedures, such as the proper way to use an escape ladder, and what to do when the smoke alarm goes off. We show how smoke travels, as well as about fire itself and its causes.

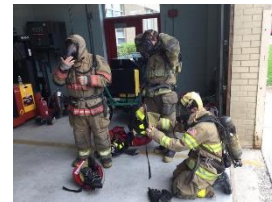
