New Public Swimming Pool Submission Requirements

Engineering plans for new public swimming pools in Rockland County must be submitted to and approved by this Department before any work is performed. The pool construction and recirculation system must meet the standards of Subpart 6-1 of the New York State Sanitary Code. The following information must be submitted for this Department to complete a review:

- 1. One complete Notice of Intent (DOH-154).
- 2. One complete NYSDOH Authorization Form.
- 3. One complete Engineering Report (DOH-1309) signed and sealed by a Licensed Engineer or Registered Architect.
- One set of supporting hydraulic calculations including head loss and design flow of the recirculation system and velocity calculations for all sizes of pipe.
- 5. One set of cut sheets for all proposed pool equipment (i.e. skimmers, filters, pumps w/ curve, etc.).
- 6. Three sets of engineering plans signed and sealed by a New York State Licensed Engineer or Registered Architect (see section 6-1.29.2.3.2 for plan requirements). Note that a site plan must be included with all submissions. When submitting plans for an indoor pool, architectural plans, HVAC mechanical plans, and building plumbing plans are typically needed to complete the review.
