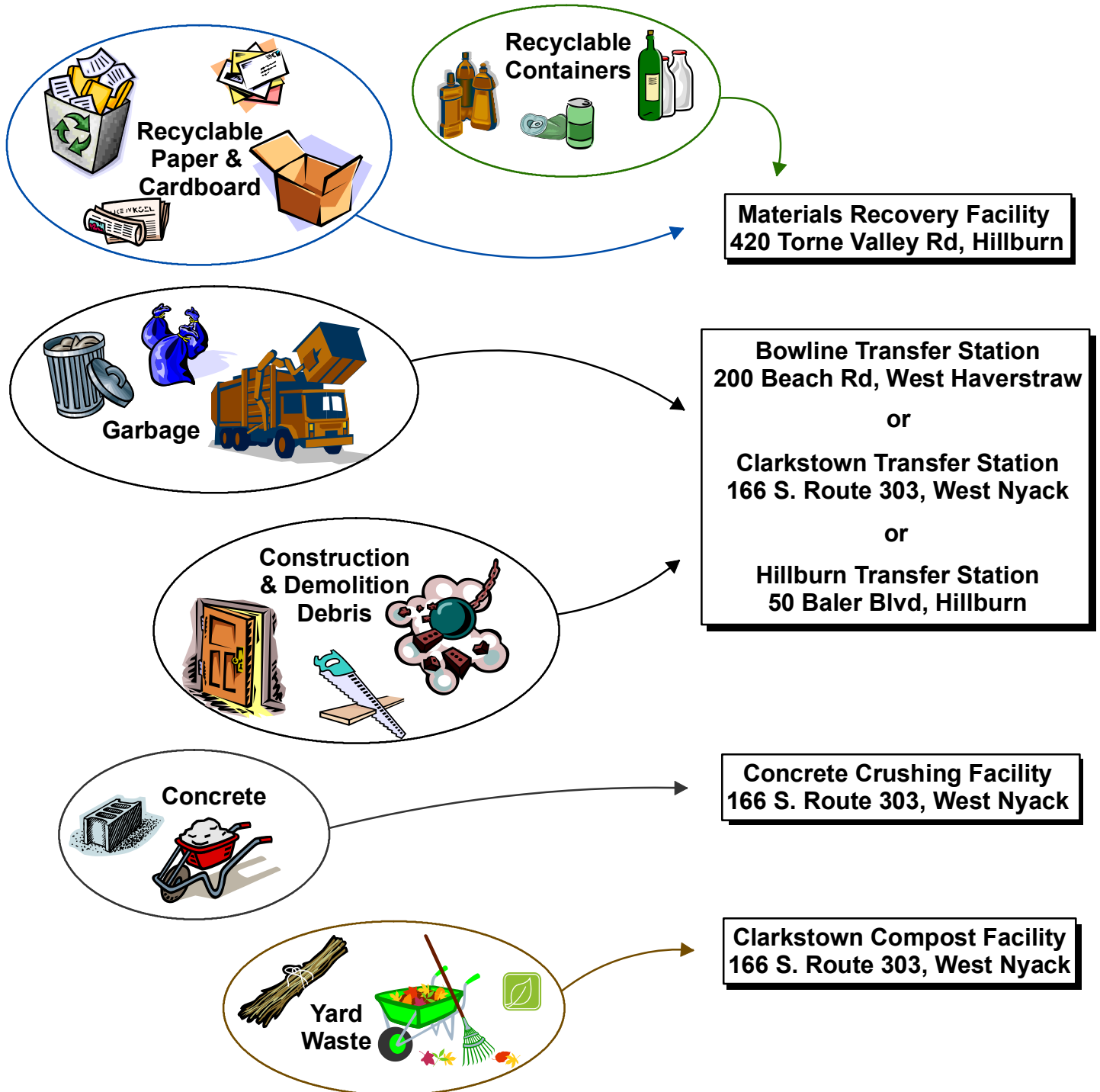




# FLOW CONTROL



- The Rockland County Flow Control Law was adopted by the Rockland County Legislature on May 20, 2008.
- The law seeks to increase the rate of recycling in the county, and provide for the safe and environmentally sound handling and disposal of the solid waste generated in Rockland County.
- The law states that **recyclables must be kept separate from all other types of waste.**
- The law states that **garbage, recyclables, construction & demolition debris, and yard waste generated in the county** must be delivered to facilities designated by the Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority.
